
Members and staff may get a UCB library card at the Privileges Desk in Doe Library for their term at SLMath, which allows you to borrow physical books from UCB campus libraries. Bring:

- your SLMath ID card (*see summer exception)
- or
- your government-issued photo ID and a letter affirming your current appointment with name and expiration date of appointment



The UCB libraries are open to the public. You do not need a card to visit them, to read books in the library, or to download ebooks and full text journal articles to your USB flash drive from their public computers.

The library card is only needed to borrow hard copy books.
